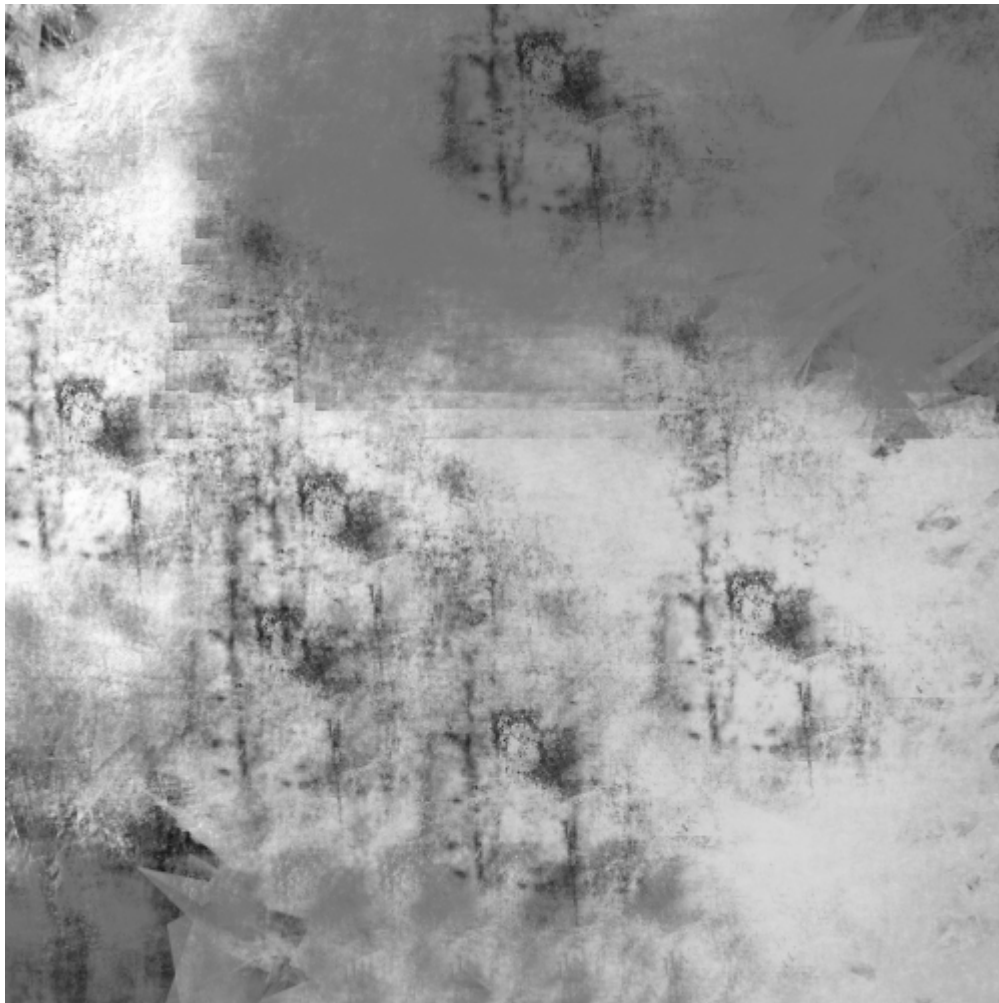


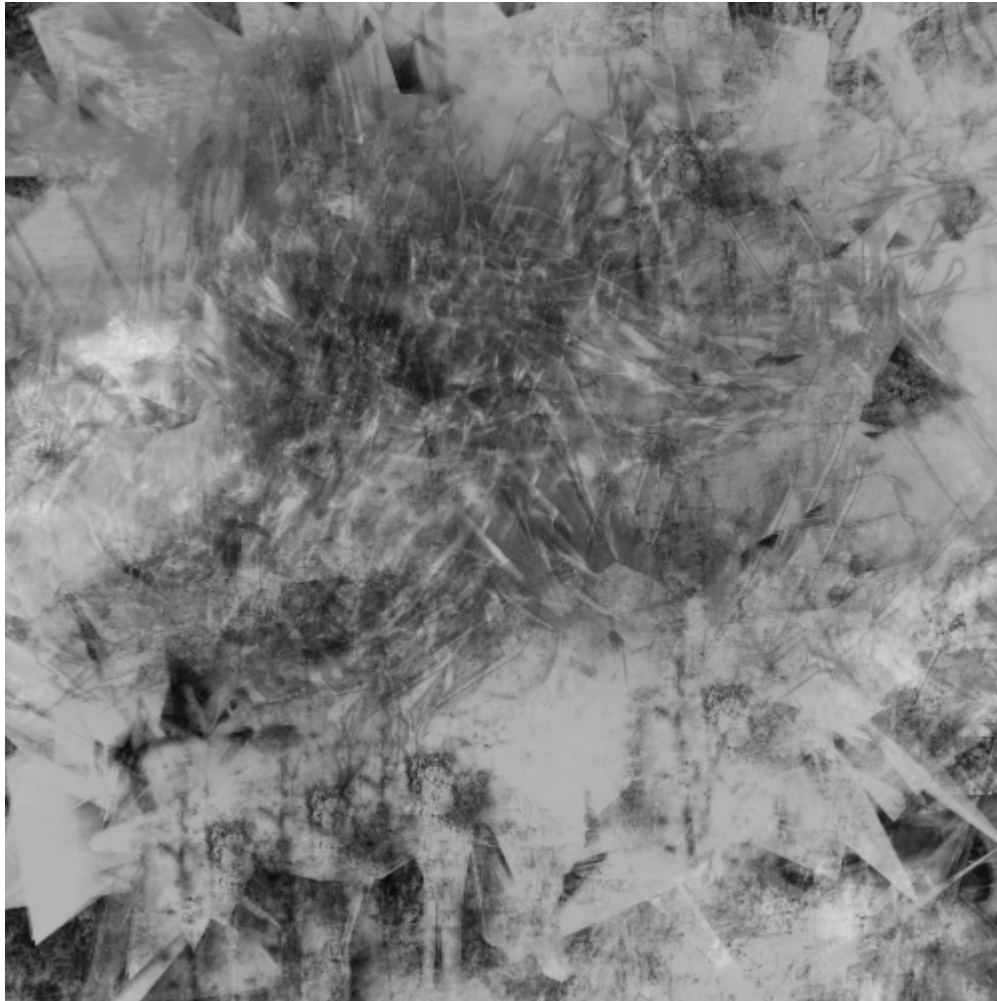


## 3D Grunge

1. Start a new 500x500 document. Fill the background with black and then make a new layer.
2. Using Grunge and Crystal brushes (or just one type if you prefer), cover the new layer with one type of the brushes. Only use grey colors.
3. Make another new layer. This time use the other type of brushes and brush until the layer underneath is somewhat visible.

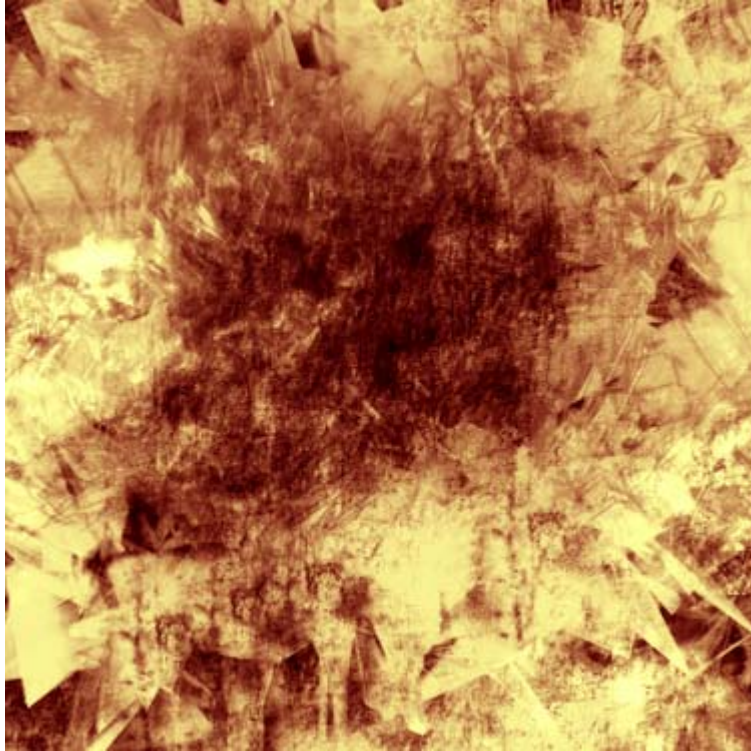


4. Ok here's where we get into the 3D part. Take your Eraser tool and select either Crystal or Grunge brushes (doesn't really matter) then erase random parts in the center of the document on both layers.



5. Time to add color. Look at the bottom of the layers palette. You will see a circle that is half white and half black. Click that circle, and then chose Color Balance. Set Shadows like the picture below. Then go to Midtones and move the red slider all the way to the right. Then go to Highlights, and move the bottom slider to around 70 on the yellow side(the left).

This is your finished project.



If it doesn't come out correctly, try erasing more, or brushing more. Once you're done, you can add text, a picture, or cut a piece out and make a signature. Go wild.
